Details

- **All applications are due Thursday, March 8th by 5 pm.**
- Check in for the parade is held at the Cody Country Chamber of Commerce at 10:15 a.m. on Saturday, March 11. You will receive lineup details and your parade number via email prior to the event, so it is important we have your email address.
- The parade will begin at 11 a.m., line up number will be provided upon check in. Even numbered entries on right hand of side of 9th Street in order i.e. 2-4-6-8 etc. Odd numbered entries on left hand side of 9th Street in order i.e. 1-3-5-7 etc.
- The parade begins at 9th street (next to mini golf) and travels east ending at 14th street (German restaurant).
- Awards will be available for pick up at the Cody Chamber on Thursday, March 15.

Rules

- Due to safety reasons, please do not throw candy from the floats. Parade walkers may hand out treats.
- Due to the participation of animals, NO excessive loud noises are permitted. This includes gun fire, fireworks, sirens, and loud engines.
- For judging purposes, be sure your number is readable for our judges. Bring tape or other fastening material to attach your float number.
- Stay in your lineup position to ensure the announcing and judging are accurate, and safety reasons with regards to animals.
- Drivers please maintain at least one-half city block between you and the entry in front of you at all times during the parade. If in doubt – stop!
